Potential Discussion Questions 2-10-19 Message: Church on the Move - Lay It On The Line

(Acts 2:14-36)

1.	Have you ever had to "lay it on the line?" What happened? What did you learn that correlates with Peter's action in Acts 2?
2.	Think about a time when you felt compelled to lay the Gospel on the line. What precipitated the opportunity? How did it go? What were your feelings in the midst of the process? How would you describe your sense of Peter's emotions in Acts 2?
3.	What evidence do you see in our text that Peter's main point was that Jesus was Israel's Messiah? What other points do you see him making? Why are they significant?
4.	How do you discern teachable moments? What most often gets in the way of seizing them?
5.	How might you present Jesus in 3 minutes to a not necessarily receptive crowd in our culture? (What would be your key points? How would you make them clear? What Scriptures would you use?
6.	Discuss the 8 major doctrines that surface in Peter's message. Why do they matter? What is their place in our presentation of Jesus as Messiah, Savior? What questions do you have about them? Do you see others addressed?
7.	What specific words/phrases point the message directly to the heart of the hearers? When God gets to your heart, how does it happen?
8.	What do you sense God speaking to your heart these days? How is He challenging and encouraging you? What in this text challenges your heart?

10. If you were to share something from this study with a friend, what would it be?

9. What would you like to discuss that hasn't already been engaged in this study?
