3.	When you were first saved, were you excited to share your faith? Has it changed over time? If so, what do you attribute that to?
4.	How do you cope with the "celebrityitis" problem in Christendom? Where have you been most tempted to get caught up in another human in a less than healthy way?
5.	Describe the change in your life after accepting Christ as your Savior. Was it dramatic or slow? How did the people around you respond? (Astonished? Skeptical? Critical? Fearful? Other?)
6.	Have you experienced "woe" from others over your relationship with Jesus? Why do you think the responses to Saul's conversion were so dramatic?
7.	How can you support others in their faith? What do you feel like you do well? Where would you like to see a change or improvement?
8.	Verse 31 provides 4 quick summary statements. We focused on the last 2 in the message. What the significance of Luke's report regarding <i>peace</i> , <i>being built up</i> , <i>the fear of the Lord</i> , <i>the comfort of the Holy Spirit</i> ? How do you see these in our church and in the Church in America?
9.	How do you practically develop the <i>fear of the Lord</i> in your life? Why is it important? How might you cultivate it even more?
