

## Potential Discussion Questions

### 10-20-19 Message: Pick 'em Up, Move 'em Out (Ac 13:1-4)

1. Share a time when God redirected you. What was the result?
2. See what you can discover about the lesser-known prophets and teachers in v 1. Why do you think God brought this group together? What does it tell you about beginning a new church or gospel movement?
3. Why is it often easier to redirect something/someone that is already moving (ministering)? Can you think of an example to illustrate this?
4. Unfortunately, leadership changes in churches often happen when there is some kind of trouble or discontent? What do we learn from this text that motivates a change for positive reasons? Where does the text clarify that this is clearly God's doing?
5. What are the spiritual passions God is stirring in your heart? How do they align with your current ministry? How might they lead to a change in your ministry?
6. Interact on how you listen to God? What does that mean in Scripture? How does God get your attention so He can direct/redirect you? Can you share a specific example?
7. Read Galatians 5:16-26 and Ephesians 5:17-20. What do these passages add to your understanding of what it means to be led by the Spirit? How do you discern that you are not listening to the Spirit?
8. The process described in this passage looks quite different from what we often see today in the setting apart of missionaries. What stands out to you? What does Luke note in Antioch that often seems missing for the 21<sup>st</sup> century church? What ideas do you have for applying Acts 13 to our missions endeavors?
9. Where is the Spirit directing you at this point in your life?
10. Share a specific prayer request related to this study and then pray for these together.
