Psalm 119:2

Danger: It's so inviting to be half-hearted.

Parallelism: equates with **keeping** His testimonies

Steady steps on God's course: Whatever it takes, Lord,
keep me steady on Your path.

Psalm 119:5

No regrets

Do not let me wander

Treasure up God's word: Whatever it takes, Lord, help me
trust and treasure Your word.

Psalm 119:11

Treasure = store up, hide, bank

Target = obedience

Open my eyes: whatever it takes, Lord, draw me to behold the
wonders of Your truth.

Psalm 119:18

A prepositional question

Peeling spiritual cataracts

Revive me: whatever it takes, Lord, revive me in Your
truth.

Psalm 119:25

We need divine reviving

How can I revive?

v 27 meditate (on your wondrous works)

v 30 choose (faithfulness)

set (your rules before me)

v 31 cling (to your testimonies)

v 32 run (in the way of your commands)
