## **Grace Goes to Court: The Trial**

Acts 15:1-12

Do you want life to be pain-free?

Sincere people collide (1-2a)

Circumcised Salvation (1)

Issue: Does the Mosaic Law place conditions on salvation and the Christian life?

A necessary but uncomfortable part of eldering

Not IF Gentiles could be saved, but **HOW** 

Collision of Law and grace

Not the first

Paul's later summary: Galatians 2:21	Conflict can be beneficial. (6-12)
If righteousness comes through Law, we don't need <b>grace</b> .	Peter summarizes the grace argument:  Historical argument (v 7-9)
Law and grace are mutually exclusive.	
Great dissension and debate (2)	Impossibility argument (10)
Conflict is never seen as enjoyable	Universal grace argument (11)
Conflict is never easy or <u>enjoyable</u> .	
Straightforward communication is essential (2b-12)  Hiding is cowardly & ineffectual.	Breakthrough requires <u>listening</u> (12)
While waiting for problems to go away they usually get worse.	Conflict differs if about <b>preference</b> rather than truth.
Addressing conflict requires intention and effort. It also opens new opportunities. (3 - 5)	Grace still goes to court!
On the way (3)	arace still goes to court:
Declared God's works (4)	
strong objection still resulted (5)	Take it Home
