1. Have you been more focused on praising God in all situations? If so, how has it impacted you this past week?
2. Share a time when God very clearly directed you into (or away from) a ministry. How do you discern God's leading in situations that are not so clear?
3. We meet several people in this text. Which one stands out most to you? Why?
4. In v 14, Luke makes it very clear that the Lord opened Lydia's heart. Read John 6:44 again. How is this significant to salvation and evangelism?
5. Do you agree that spiritual battles rage? What are some other passages that indicate this?

What helps you stand strong and remain faithful despite spiritual battles?

What clues you in that you are in the midst of a spiritual battle?

6. What are some issues in our current world that lead people to say the gospel is foolish? How do/can you respond?
7. How would your life be different if salvation were by works rather than grace? Be specific.
8. What do you see as the most important lesson from this passage for 21st Century believers?
9. What would you like to discuss from this passage that hasn't been addressed?
10. Share one thing from this passage that you have learned or that challenges you in your walk with God.
