- 1. How do you determine what matters most?
- 2. In a "WOKE" world, where everyone is screaming and hollering about anything and everything, how can we hold convictions with respect and treat differences with dignity? What Scriptures help guide you?
- 3. Do the 3 diagrams help you visualize the various views regarding the Millennial Kingdom? How would you summarize the key issues in each position? What questions still come to mind?
- 4. Read Matthew 24:3-14. How does this help direct your anticipation of what's coming?
- 5. How do we properly look for "the signs of the end of the age" without becoming obsessed with them?
- 6. In Romans chapters 9-11 Paul speaks at length to the question of Israel's place after rejecting Jesus. What insight does this passage give on a future for Israel?
- 7. How would you respond to a person that says the Jewish nation is rejected by God because they rejected Jesus in His first coming?
- 8. Sometimes we miss the connection of world events to the development of theology. Does it surprise you that the amillennial view gained its early advocates after the political blending of church and state and a subsequent Roman theology stating that the church was the Kingdom of God on earth? Similarly, a strong rise in the support of premillennialism occurred after the Jewish state was again established in 1948. How should these events impact our understanding of Scripture?
- 9. What issues do you see in a spiritualizing interpretation of prophecy?
- 10. What would you like to discuss from this message that hasn't been addressed?
