

# Potential Discussion Questions

## Message 2020-3-15, The Noble Road (Ac 17:10-15)

This week I'm giving you a little different approach. This is a fairly short passage, so it's not too complicated to work with. Read through the text 2 or 3 times (at least). You could even try reading in 2 or more different translations, noting the differences. Then go back through the text using the following set of questions. See what you discover and share your insights, questions, and applications with each other.

1. What's going on in the story/passage?
2. How do I see myself and/or my world in this account?
3. What excites, inspires, or encourages me about the passage?
4. What challenges, jolts, confuses, or even offends me about the passage?
5. What does this tell us about the essence of God or the nature of Jesus?
6. What does this tell us about the nature of man and the challenges we face?
7. What stood out to me in the pastor's message on this text?
8. What will we do with what we just heard/learned in the next seven days?
9. How does this passage prompt me to pray for myself and others?
