- 1. What is something (or a season) in your life that has demanded determination and perseverance?
- 2. How do you see ease as a greater threat to progress than hardship? Share a personal example, if you can.
- 3. Reread Acts 17:1-9. What stands out most to you?
- 4. Take a shot at explaining from the Old Testament how Messiah must die and be raised.
- 5. What responses to this message do you see in the text? If you were a Jew in that synagogue, what would be going through your head and heart?
- 6. Have you ever wrestled with jealousy? How did it impact you? What helped you overcome it, If you have?
- 7. Look up some other biblical passages on jealousy. What do you learn from them?
- 8. It can feel in America like the gospel is not turning the world upside down. See if you can find some statistics on the world-wide impact of the gospel. What do you learn?
 - We can easily measure things only by what we see. How do or can you expand your understanding and appreciation for gospel impact in the world?
- 9. Review the four principles suggested for living with persevering determination. Which stands out to you most? Why?
 - Do you see others in this text you would like to share?
- 10. What would you like to discuss from this message that hasn't been addressed?
