Exodus 5:1-6:1**

Ever get a serious push back?

First request (Ex 5:1)

...Let My people go...

Push Back (5:2-5)

Who? I do not know the Lord. (5:2)

Ignorance is no excuse.

Ignorance does not end our accountability to God.

More ask, more push (5: 3-5)

Oppression enforces control

Straw-gate: When life gets worse, not better (5:6-21)

Sometimes God allows things to get worse

Be careful how you respond under such circumstances.

Attack the messenger (5:20-23)

Pain easily brings blame.

Spontaneous lament

That God does not deliver quickly does not mean
He is not present and active!

It takes eyes of faith to walk clearly & securely.

Implementation dip

God gives the last word (6:1)

Take it Home
