Exodus 6:1-13

Myopia

Four key themes

God's purpose overwhelms the push back! (6:1)

Keep your eyes open to God's work

Now you will see what I will do...

Nothing with God is ready, fire, aim

We are prone to ignore God's explicit promise & faithful character (6:2-8)

God is gracious to reiterate who He is & how He works.

This is how we overcome spiritual myopia.

Revealing, Almighty, Covenant keeper, hearing, faithful

Do you have a place where you feel God has checked out on you?

bring out, deliver, redeem, make you my people, be your God, fulfill my promises (into the land)

Caution: we need more than an emotional experience of God.

God is not stopped by our faithlessness & rejection. (6:9)

broken spirit and harsh slavery

Prov 17:22, 18:14

Pain/oppression and discouragement seek to strip our eyes off God and steal His promises.

God persists (6:10-13)

Problem of seeing through limitation rather than the promise and power of God.

Contrast the "I am ..." of Moses with the "I am ..." of God.
