## **Suggested Discussion Questions for 2/28/2021**

Walk the (Covid-19) Wilderness with Moses, pt 21: God's House (Ex 20:21ff)

1.	God put a lot into the Tabernacle (and later, Temple). In your opinion, what is the appropriate investment in the aesthetics of our worship spaces? Given that believers, not the building, is now God's dwelling place, how does that factor into your thinking?
2.	Describe in your own words the significance of the Tabernacle?
3.	Why do you think Scripture gives so much space to this topic?
4.	It's not an accident that a commitment (recommitment) of the nation immediately precedes all these instructions. What is the most recent specific commitment to obedience to God you have made? Is there need for a refresh or new affirmation of your commitment?
5.	How would/should such an unusual and symbolic structure impact God's people? How do you respond to it?
6.	When you consider that you are a living temple of God, what thoughts and responses do you have? Do you think most believers really embrace this in daily life? Why or why not?
7.	How has the COVID season impacted your desire to gather with other believers? In what ways might it increase our passion and joy?
8.	Which do you feel most in need of post-Covid: encouraged faith, enriched fellowship, or opportunities for service?
9.	Is there a new area of service God is placing on your heart? What needs to happen to get engaged?

10. What challenge or encouragement do you want to take from this study?
