Suggested Discussion Questions for 3/21/2021

Walk the (Covid-19) Wilderness with Moses, pt 23:
The Blessings of Obedience (Numbers 13-14; Deuteronomy 28)

- 1. What makes your list of "the things that really matter in life"? How did this message help you consider obeying God as something that needs to be on the list?
- 2. Discuss the reality that God often conditions blessing upon obedience. How do you answer the person who says: "If God is really loving, He can't only do good to those who follow Him?"
- 3. Reread Deuteronomy 28. Sit and think about all the "blessings" God promises those who obey. How do you respond? How does it challenge you?
- 4. Read again the account of the 12 spies in Numbers 13-14. What stands out most to you? Why?
- 5. What are your greatest challenges to simply taking God at His word?
- 6. If we really believe obedience brings blessing, why do we so easily balk at God's commands?
- 7. What faithless voices do you need to tune out these days? How do you do it?
- 8. Where are you currently challenged to step forward in faith as you obey God's word?
- 9. How might we cultivate the *different kind of spirit* Joshua and Caleb evidenced?
- 10. What thoughts, desires and/or actions do the chapters in this study inspire in you?
- 11. What would you like to discuss that has not already been raised?
