Sharing Your Faith in a Post-Christian World, Ac 17,22-34

1. What is your favorite approach to sharing your faith?
2. How do you find sharing your faith in today's world different than it was 20+ years ago?
3. What do you find as the best points of commonality for talking with people about Jesus?
4. Create your own list of "A, B, C's" to help you remember ways to seek understanding and commonality. Share them with each other. Maybe you can edit your own list based on other ideas shared.
5. Is it easy or hard for you to listen to others who don't share your faith without trying to correct their views (at least at first)? Why? What helps do you have for constructive listening?
6. In what ways do you see Paul interfacing with the generally held beliefs of Stoics and Epicureans in his brief message?
7. What do you see as significant elements that proclaim God in Paul's message that could be relevant or adapted for our current faith conversations?
8. In the end, Paul's call to repent is clear and tied to the consequence of rejecting Jesus. What stands out to you about his approach? Is there any helpful guidance for you in this?
9. What helps you overcome the fear of offending someone if you speak up about your faith?
10. Luke records a variety of responses. How does this help, encourage or challenge you?
11. What is your best take-away from this study? How can it help you this week?
