

Suggested Discussion Questions for 6/27/2021

Ephesus is a Riot (Ac 19:21-41)

1. Share a time when your faith collided with non-Christian culture.
2. What is a clear time in your life when you were “resolved in the Spirit” to take a specific direction? How do you know it’s the Spirit and not something else?
3. How have you seen Proverbs 16:9 work out in your life? Do you have any current plans you are surrendering to the Lord for confirmation of His direction?
4. When you read Acts 19:23-34, what stands out most to you? How are you encouraged? How are you challenged?
5. How do transformed people produce (through God’s work) transformed cities?

How can you see this playing out in Cayucos/Morro Bay?

How might it impact some of the current struggles tearing cities apart in the US?
6. What aspect of our current culture do you think most likely draws people away from the transforming work of the gospel? How about you personally?
7. Read Isaiah 40 and note all the ways that exalt God’s power and sovereignty over nations and rulers? What response does this draw from you?
8. God often uses those who do not believe in or follow Him to accomplish His purposes. Brainstorm a list of favorite biblical examples. How does this comfort us in our current world?
9. What would you like to discuss from this study that has not been covered yet?
