

Suggested Discussion Questions for 11/7/2021

No Accident

1. Have you previously heard the story/analogy that began the message? How did our discussion of its strengths and weaknesses strike you?
2. Reread Acts 2:22-23 and reflect on the impact of Jesus being delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God. How would you explain the significance of this to an unbeliever?
3. Have you ever experienced an “I don’t want that kind of father” response? How would you explain the fallacy in this statement?
4. Think about the realities of what God has done for you in Christ. Which ones presented in our study resonated most with you? What others would you add?
5. Read back through the additional verses listed on the outline. How do these help underscore that the death of Christ was no accident? What other key truths do they address?
6. Isaiah 53 is one of the most significant Messianic prophecies in the Old Testament. Reflect on how it touches your heart and motivates your relationship with God?
7. What differences does it make to our salvation if the death of Christ actually were an accident?
8. How does this truth give you security in your relationship with God?
9. What stood out to you in this study that hasn’t been addressed yet?
10. What in this study encourages your relationship and your walk with God?
