Choices

Zeal alone is not enough (1-4)

Some things fall short

According to knowledge

Zeal for the gospel leads to proclamation (5-17)

Law and faith revisited (5-8)

Argument: Deuteronomy 30:11-20

Accessibility and the will of God

Problem: not God's choosing but Israel's lack of response

The essentials (9-13)

Confess – Jesus as Lord

Believe – in Jesus' resurrection

Assurance – you will be saved

Non-discrimination policy: *everyone*

Preaching = public declaration

Hearing ⇨ something said to be heard
