2. How does the Old Testament matter to you? What is a specific way it has instructed you and helped direct your growth in your faith?

3. What are some specific ways the Scripture encourages and builds hope for you?

4. What can we learn from the non-first world about endurance, suffering and hope?

5. Read 1 Corinthians 10:1-13. How does it relate to this passage and what does it add to your understanding and application?

6. How does Paul connect hope, relational harmony and the glory of God in this passage?

7. This passage underscores the hope for all mankind in the good news of Jesus. How do these passages (Deut 32:43; Ps 18:49, 117:1; 2 Sam 22:50, & Isa 11:10) contribute to Paul's argument?

8. What helps you abound in hope? How does this passage say that happens?

9. What would you like to discuss that hasn't yet been addressed?

10. What is your greatest take-away from this study?
