

**Suggested Discussion Questions for 11/6/2022 Message:
It's All For His Glory, Romans 16:17-27**

1. Share a difficult conversation that resulted in something positive? What did you learn through the experience?

2. Share a highlight for you in understanding and/or applying the truths of Romans to your life?

3. Why do you think Paul had to warn the Romans so strongly about those who are divisive and create obstacles? Why don't we naturally see and deal with these things?

4. How do you respond to the instruction to *avoid them*? How do you deal with the accusation that to do so is being unkind/unloving/judgmental?

5. What specific reason for avoiding such people does Paul give? Why are they important?

6. How do you find peace in knowing the ultimate triumph of Christ over Satan?

7. What stands out most to you in the final verses (25-27)? How are they a fitting capstone or summary of the book?

8. What is one specific way Romans has challenged you to increased obedience?

9. What would you like to discuss from this passage that hasn't yet been addressed?
