- 7. How are forgiveness and reconciliation related?
- 8. Using the passages discussed, how would you explain the concept of reconciliation to God?
- 9. According to 2 Corinthians 5, if we are reconciled to God, we ARE messengers of reconciliation. What does that look like in your life?
- 10. Humanly, we can forgive but not be reconciled? Why is that and how does it look in our experience?
- 11. What would you like to discuss about forgiveness and reconciliation that hasn't been raised?
