4. Which of the implications presented stands out most to you? Why?
5. What other implications of forgiveness would you like to add?
6. This study focused on God's forgiveness of us. Scripture also says a lot about our forgiveness of each other? How do these passages help us in forgiving each other?
7. How are forgiveness and reconciliation related?
8. Using the passages discussed, how would you explain the concept of reconciliation to God?
9. According to 2 Corinthians 5, if we are reconciled to God, we ARE messengers of reconciliation. What does that look like in your life?
10. Humanly, we can forgive but not be reconciled? Why is that and how does it look in our experience?
11. What would you like to discuss about forgiveness and reconciliation that hasn't been raised?
