

Discussion Questions on 10/13 Message

Enoch: The Walk that Pleases Our God

Scriptures Referenced in Message: Genesis 5:21-24; Jude 14-15; Hebrews 11:5-6; Romans 8:1; Romans 12:1-2; 1 John 2:1-2; Amos 3:3

1. As a group, try to finish this sentence: "Walking with God means..."
(There may be several things that come to mind).
2. Read Hebrews 11:5. Enoch pleased God. What is the difference between walking to appease God, and walking to please him?
3. What is the difference between walking to GAIN God's acceptance, and walking BECAUSE of God's acceptance?
4. Read 1 John 2:1-2. Discuss: How is it that a Holy God Who hates sin can find pleasure in walking with us? What had to happen?
5. Read Romans 8:1-4. In what ways might Romans 8:1-4 give us freedom to walk with God in a healthy way?
6. Read Hebrews 13:20-21. What things do these verses say **had** to happen, and **still need** to happen, in order for us to walk in a way that pleases our Heavenly Father?
7. Read Romans 12:1-2. According to these verses, what should we keep in mind in order to please God? What practical steps does the passage say we can take to walk in a way that pleases God?
