- 3. (V.1) Paul says he took this trip to Jerusalem in response to a Revelation. God told Him to go. What are some possible reasons God might have wanted Paul to go before the apostles in Jerusalem?
- 4. Even though Paul proclaimed his independence from the Apostles, how does this trip also show his solidarity with them?
- 5. (Vss. 1,3) What advantage might there have been in Paul taking Titus along?
- 6. Why do you think it was important for Paul to stand up for freedom from the Old Testament Law?
- 7. (V.2) Why did Paul choose to meet privately with the leaders, rather than in a public meeting?
- 8. (Vss. 6-10) What responses do you see from the Apostles? List them. What might this tell us about their character?
- 9. In the first century, why would "remembering the poor" be important to the spread of the Gospel?
- 10. In our community today, what are some things the apostles would say to us to "remember", which could affect the credibility of our message?
