Message #10: Gal. 3:15-18 Why Nothing Cancels Out the Promise of God

1. What is the oldest legal document you have? Is it still valid? Why or why not?

Read Galatians 3:15-18

2. What practical truth does Paul refer to in v.15, and what is he trying to convey?
3. What is the promise/covenant referred to in verse 16? (See verses 6-9; Also, Genesis 12:2-3)
4. To whom was the promise made? (verse 16) How does that make the promise especially unbreakable?
5. How long after this promise/covenant was the Covenant of the Law given?
6. What does Paul say about the Law replacing the original Covenant?
7. What blessings can you see in this truth, that the Law does not cancel out the promise of God?
8. Where would we be today if the Law did cancel or replace the promise of God? How would our walks with God be different?
9. What do you think motivates people to go back under the Law?
10. How would you counsel someone who seems to be looking to commandments and rituals for their assurance of acceptance before God?
