Paul's Biblical Argument for Justification through Faith
Galatians 3:6-14

The Path to God's Blessing (Justification) is the Path of _____. (Vss. 6-9)

- A Biblical Example: Abraham was "Blessed" (Justified) by faith not Law-keeping. (V.6)

- A Biblical Promise: All Nations are "Blessed" through Faith, as Abraham Was. (V.7-9)

The Path to God's Curse (Condemnation) is the Path of _____. (V.10-14)

- A Biblical Warning: The Law Places Us under a Curse. (V.10-12; Deut.27:26; Hab. 2:4; Lev.18:5)

...Because it requires perfect obedience (Eccles.7:20; Romans 3:10,23; James 2:10)

- A Biblical Declaration: Christ Has Redeemed Us from that Curse. (V.13-14)
