Discussion Questions for 4/6/25 Message

Helping Each Other to Walk in the Spirit - Galatians 5:24-6:5

Scriptures Referenced: Gal. 5:24-6:5; 2:20; James 1:20; 1 Pet. 5:8; Eccl. 4:9-12.

1.	Illustrate practically what it means to "crucify" the sinful nature (5:24).
2.	How does the idea of "crucifying our sinful nature" affect our daily lives and our interactions with others (5:24)?
3.	What are some practical steps we can take to guard against wrong actions and attitudes, as we help others?
4.	Create a couple of contrasting statements you might use in helping someone who is trapped in the sin of bitterness: First, write an approach without gentleness, and then an approach with gentleness.
5.	What does it mean to "restore" someone who is caught in a sin (6:1)?
6.	How is "carrying one's own load" different from "carrying the burdens of others"? (Verse 2,5)
7.	What is the "Law of Christ" here (v.2)?
8.	What are some things that encourage you to keep going in your walk and in Christian service when you feel like giving up?
